## Forward Fun Zone Opens in Marshfield, Bringing Inclusive Play to the Community

MARSHFIELD, WI — A community vision more than a year in the making has officially become a reality with the grand opening and ribbon cutting of the new Forward Fun Zone, an all-inclusive playground designed to provide a place where children of all

welcomed families to the celebration and recognized the Leadership Marshfield program and the residents who came together to make the project possible.

"I'm really happy on behalf of the City of Marshfield to welcome you all here," Poeschel told those gathered before welcoming the children who would become the first to officially play on the new playground.

The Forward Fun Zone project was led

by Leadership Marshfield participants Connie Mikulski, Abby Meyer, Lindsay Safford and Bill Thomas. The four did not know each other before participating in Leadership

Marshfield but formed a team that ultimately took on one of the program's largest projects.

Mikulski told those gathered that the playground represented much more than the work of a single group.

"Tonight isn't simply about opening a playground," she said, describing the project as an example of what can happen when an entire community comes together.

Organizers credited businesses, foundations, individual donors and volunteers with helping turn the idea into reality. Donations ranged from individual dollars to contributions reaching as high as \$200,000, according to remarks made during the ceremony.

Volunteers also contributed thousands of hours during the approximately year-and-a-half effort.

The project also received assistance from playground manufacturing and installation professionals, contractors, landscapers and Marshfield Parks and Recreation Department staff. Organizers specifically recognized Northland Recreation, Bach Excavating, Decorative Concrete and Design, Marwood and others who helped prepare and complete the site.

Marshfield Parks and Recreation - Parks Superintendent Ben Steinbach accepted the playground into the city's park system during the ceremony, saying the project continues Marshfield's history of community support for its parks.

"These partnerships make a tremendous difference," Steinbach said, noting that community partnerships allow the Parks and Recreation Department to accomplish projects that otherwise may not be possible.

The celebration also provided an opportunity to support other organizations serving the Marshfield area. Donations were collected for an animal rescue organization, while the Marshfield Area United Way collected cereal, peanut butter and jelly for its

abilities can play together.

Community members, local leaders, volunteers, families and plenty of excited children gathered for the celebration, marking the completion of a project that began through the Leadership Marshfield Class of 2025. Organizers said what started as a conversation among four Leadership Marshfield participants eventually grew into an ambitious community-wide effort.

The result is an \$860,000 all-inclusive playground, built around the idea that every child should have an opportunity to play and feel included.

Nutrition On Weekends program. The program served 682 children and distributed approximately 20,000 food packs during the previous year, according to remarks at the event. For those who helped bring Forward Fun Zone from an idea to a completed playground, the ribbon cutting represented the culmination of months of fundraising, planning, construction and volunteer work — and the beginning of something intended to serve Marshfield families for generations.

As the ceremony concluded, organizers thanked the community for believing in the project and in its children before finally giving the words the young crowd had been waiting to hear:

“Now, let’s officially open the Forward Fun Zone!”

The announcement was followed by cheers as children headed onto Marshfield’s newest playground for the first time.

MARSHFIELD, Wis. — Businesses, healthcare providers, community organizations, and nonprofit groups are invited to participate as exhibitors in the 2026 Senior Health Fair, scheduled for Friday, October 2, at the 2nd Street Community Center in Marshfield.



Hosted by the Marshfield Parks & Recreation Department, the Marshfield Senior Citizens Council (MSCC), and the Committee on Aging, the annual event provides exhibitors with an

opportunity to connect directly with older adults and caregivers from across the Marshfield area.

The Senior Health Fair is expected to feature approximately 50 exhibitors offering information on healthcare, wellness, senior services, community resources, and programs that promote healthy and independent living. The event also includes a guest speaker, health screenings, demonstrations, lunch, door prizes, and other activities designed to educate and engage attendees.

The event will take place from 9:00 a.m. to 1:00 p.m. on Friday, October 2, with the guest speaker scheduled from 9:15 to 10:00 a.m. and the exhibitor show opening at 10:00 a.m. Exhibitors are encouraged to set up on Thursday, October 1, from 3:00 to 4:00 p.m., although setup will also be available on Friday morning from 8:00 to 10:00 a.m.

The registration fee is \$50 per exhibit table, and organizers ask each exhibitor to donate a door prize that will be raffled off during the event. Organizations needing electrical service should indicate that on their registration form and provide their own 50-foot extension cord.

Completed registration forms and payment must be received by Friday, August 21. Registrations received after that date will be subject to a \$10 late fee. Checks should be made payable to Marshfield Parks & Recreation and mailed to 211 E. Second Street, Marshfield, WI 54449. Electronic payment options are also available.

Following registration, exhibitors will receive additional event details, including schedules and booth maps, by email. Organizers also encourage participants to watch the Marshfield Parks & Recreation and Marshfield Senior Center – WI Facebook pages for event updates.

## Wood County Sheriff’s Department Joins ‘Drive Sober or Get Pulled Over’ Campaign

WOOD COUNTY, Wis. — The Wood County Sheriff’s Department is joining law enforcement agencies across Wisconsin and the nation for the annual Drive Sober or Get Pulled Over campaign, increasing impaired-driving enforcement ahead of Labor Day weekend.



The enforcement campaign began Aug. 19 and continues through Sept. 7. During that time, officers will conduct additional enforcement and education efforts aimed at preventing crashes caused by impaired driving.

“Driving impaired puts everyone on the road in danger,” Wood County Sheriff Shawn Becker said. “Someone is injured or killed in an impaired driving crash every 2.5 hours in Wisconsin. Leading up to Labor Day weekend, we are focusing our enforcement and education efforts on preventing impaired driving so travelers can get to their destinations safely.”

According to information provided by the Sheriff’s Department, Wisconsin recorded nearly 7,000 impaired-driving crashes in 2025, resulting in 167 deaths. Alcohol was involved in more than one-quarter of all traffic fatalities in the state.

Authorities are also reminding motorists that impairment is not

limited to alcohol. Drugs, including some prescription and over-the-counter medications, can affect a person's ability to safely operate a vehicle. Wisconsin recorded 1,636 drug-related crashes last year, resulting in 71 deaths.

Law enforcement agencies across Wisconsin have expanded training and resources to identify impaired drivers. More than 8,000 officers have received Advanced Roadside Impaired Driving Enforcement training, while nearly 400 officers are trained as Drug Recognition Experts. The state also has 34 multi-jurisdictional enforcement task forces operating throughout the year.

The Wood County Sheriff's Department is encouraging people who plan to drink during Labor Day celebrations to designate a sober driver in advance or arrange another safe way home. Drivers and passengers are also reminded to buckle up, put phones down, watch their speed and eliminate distractions.

Anyone who suspects an impaired driver is urged to call 911 and provide as much information as possible about the vehicle, driver and location.

Officials also encourage residents to take advantage of safe-ride programs offered by some bars and restaurants, public transportation or rideshare services rather than getting behind the wheel while impaired.

The Drive Sober or Get Pulled Over campaign continues through Labor Day weekend, ending Sept. 7.

## **Plans Take Shape for Restoration of Marshfield's Historic Columbia Park Bandshell**

MARSHFIELD, WI — A piece of Marshfield history could receive new life under a proposed restoration project aimed at preserving the Columbia Park Bandshell while making the nearly century-old structure safer,

more accessible and useful for future generations.

Preservation architect Mark Zettler of Zettler Design Studio presented an architectural and historic analysis of the bandshell to the Marshfield Parks, Recreation and Forestry Committee on Wednesday, Aug. 19. Zettler, a Marshfield native, was hired by the city to examine the structure and develop concepts for its restoration.



Columbia Park itself dates nearly to the beginning of Marshfield. The land was included in the city's original plat and was donated to the city by Samuel Marsh, for whom Marshfield is named, in 1875. Originally known as Northside Park, it was renamed Columbia Park in 1915.

The park's first bandstand was built in 1903. That gazebo-style structure was condemned and removed in 1927. After two proposed replacements were rejected as too expensive, a smaller Art Deco design was approved in 1931 during the Great Depression. That structure is the Columbia Park Bandshell that remains today.

The bandshell has undergone improvements over the decades, including restroom work in 1984

and a major restoration in 2009 that addressed structural and masonry issues. Zettler said much of the work completed in 2009 continues to hold up well.

However, nearly a century of Wisconsin weather has taken its toll.

Parts of the stage floor exposed to snow and moisture have deteriorated and become spongy, while portions

protected by the building's winter cover remain in considerably better condition. Water drainage from the roof has also contributed to deterioration of masonry and rusting of the building's historic steel windows.

The roof itself may be original to the 1931 structure. Zettler said a substantial buildup of moss, pine needles and leaves is currently sitting on the roof, contributing to water entering the building.

One of the largest challenges facing the historic structure is accessibility. The bandshell currently does not meet modern accessibility requirements, with the stage elevated above ground level and no ramp or lift available.

The proposed restoration would address that problem with an accessible ramp

serving both the stage and restrooms. Zettler noted the ramp would also benefit musicians and performers moving heavy instruments and equipment onto the stage.

The existing restrooms would also be reconfigured into two accessible single-use restrooms. Each would include a toilet, sink, grab bars, baby-changing station and other necessary fixtures. The project could also include limited heating in the restroom area to prevent pipes from freezing and eliminate the need to winterize the plumbing each year.

Other proposed improvements include a new roof, gutters and downspouts; repairs to damaged masonry and stage flooring; updated electrical service; improved stage and exit lighting; code-compliant exits; additional electrical outlets; and possible accent lighting around the bandshell's Art Deco proscenium arch.

The goal is not to reinvent the historic structure.

From the front, Zettler said the bandshell would continue to look largely as it does today, with repairs made to deteriorated materials while preserving its historic character.

The restoration could also open the bandshell to additional uses beyond traditional concerts, including theater performances and other community events.

A second phase could eventually extend beyond the bandshell itself and restore elements of Columbia Park's historic design. Concepts include recreating the park's original diagonal pathways, installing lighting along the walks and improving the seating area in front of the bandshell. Historic records show the park once featured two diagonal paths meeting near the center.

The preliminary price tag for the

bandshell-focused first phase is approximately \$565,000 before contingency, although officials hope to find ways to reduce the scope closer to the approximately \$500,000 target previously discussed by the committee. A broader second phase involving park improvements was estimated at approximately \$300,000, depending on how much of the concept is ultimately pursued.

During the meeting, committee member Donna Rozar said community members have begun contributing, including one \$10,000 donation. She estimated fundraising may already be approaching \$100,000, while officials also discussed the possibility of approximately \$100,000 in grants and other historic preservation funding opportunities.

Rozar said the effort is intended to be a community-wide project rather than something supported by only a small group of donors.

"I want this to be a collaborative thing," she told the committee, emphasizing the importance of community buy-in for the restoration.

There is not yet a firm construction timeline. The project is expected to move next into continued fundraising, followed by finalizing the scope of work, preparing construction documents and eventually seeking bids.

At the conclusion of the presentation, the Parks, Recreation and Forestry Committee unanimously accepted Zettler's report and placed it on file. Accepting the report does not commit the city to completing every element proposed in the study.

For a bandshell built during the Great Depression and a park that has been part of Marshfield since the city's earliest years, the effort represents more than a building project. It is an opportunity to preserve a familiar piece

of Marshfield's past while preparing it to continue serving the community well into the future.

## **UWSP at Marshfield to Mark 25th Anniversary of September 11 with Special Presentation**

MARSHFIELD, Wis. — Twenty-five years after the September 11 terrorist attacks, the University of Wisconsin-Stevens Point at Marshfield and McMillan Memorial Library will host a special presentation offering a personal perspective on the events of that historic day and their lasting impact.



"September 11: One Man's Story, 25 Years Later" will be presented from 1 to 2:30 p.m. Tuesday, Sept. 8. The program is free and open to the public.

In Marshfield, the presentation will be held at the UW-Stevens Point at Marshfield Everett Roehl STEM Building, Jean's Vanguard Room, 2000 W. 5th St. A second location will be available at McMillan Memorial Library, 490 E. Grand Ave., Wisconsin Rapids. Participants may also attend virtually through Zoom. An RSVP is recommended.

The program will feature Doug Edwards, whose personal connection to September 11 provides a unique perspective on the attacks and the years that followed.

Edwards and his family moved to the New York City area in 2000. At the time of the attacks, his office was located in the North Tower of the World Trade Center. Edwards was traveling for work on September 11, 2001, and was not in

the building when the attacks occurred.

Now retired, Edwards serves as a dedicated 9/11 volunteer, sharing his experiences to help others better understand the events of that day and their continuing impact. Through personal stories and reflections, he will discuss September 11, the years that followed and the importance of remembering the past while looking toward the future.

The presentation is made possible through the Tunnel to Towers



Foundation, an organization founded in honor of New York City firefighter Stephen Siller, who died while responding to the September 11 attacks. The foundation works

to honor first responders and military members, support their families and preserve the memory and lessons of September 11.

“This program provides an opportunity to remember, reflect and hear a personal story connected to one of the most significant events in our nation’s history,” Program Manager Rebecca Bauer said. “As we mark 25 years, we hope this presentation will help participants remember those who were lost, learn from the past and consider the importance of carrying those stories forward.”

The September 11 attacks occurred 25 years ago this year, on Sept. 11, 2001, when nearly 3,000 people were killed in coordinated terrorist attacks in New York City, at the Pentagon and aboard United Airlines Flight 93 in Pennsylvania.

The Sept. 8 program is free and open to the public, with advance registration recommended for those planning to attend in person or virtually.

## Quality Tank Solutions Expansion to Bring 30 New Jobs to Marshfield

MARSHFIELD, Wis. — Quality Tank Solutions is preparing for a major expansion in Marshfield that company leaders say will create approximately 30 new jobs, increase manufacturing capabilities and provide new workforce development opportunities for local students.

The company is moving forward with a nearly 100,000-square-foot manufacturing facility that will allow Quality Tank Solutions to produce significantly larger stainless steel tanks. The new building will stand approximately 60 feet tall.

Quality Tank Solutions currently has the ability to manufacture tanks up to approximately 50,000 gallons. Once the new facility is operational, that capacity will increase to around 100,000 gallons. Company officials said demand for increasingly larger tanks helped drive the decision to expand.



The tanks manufactured by the Marshfield company are used primarily for raw products and storage, with many serving the dairy and food and beverage industries. Products stored in the tanks can include raw milk, whey proteins and other ingredients used by processing facilities.

Expansion Expected to Create 30 Jobs

Beyond increasing production capabilities, the project is expected to have a significant impact on the local workforce.

Company officials said approximately 30 new jobs will be created as part of the expansion. Quality Tank Solutions is also focusing on developing its existing workforce through training, apprenticeship programs and opportunities for employees to advance into different positions within the company.

The new positions will not be limited to welding and fabrication. Quality Tank Solutions expects opportunities in office positions, shipping and receiving, machine operation and other areas of the company.

Building the Next Generation of Workers

Quality Tank Solutions is also working with local schools to introduce students to careers in manufacturing and related fields.

The company is developing apprenticeship and workforce programs that could expose students to welding and fabrication as well as engineering, design, office and human resources careers. Students could spend approximately 12 weeks with the

company, giving them an opportunity to experience different careers before deciding which direction they may want to pursue.

Company officials said manufacturing today involves a much broader range of careers than many students may realize, including electrical work, automation, design, CAD, estimating and machine

operation.

## Community Invited to Sept. 18 Celebration

The public will have an opportunity to learn more about the expansion during Quality Tank Solutions' Building Connections QTS Celebration on Friday, Sept. 18, from 11 a.m. to 1 p.m.

The event is designed to give community members a closer look at the company, its existing operations and the expansion underway. Visitors will be able to learn more about what takes place inside the facility and the types of career opportunities available at Quality Tank Solutions.

The expansion comes after years of organic growth for the Marshfield company. Quality Tank Solutions has been in business for 14 years, with company leaders saying much of its early growth occurred without extensive marketing. With the new facility and additional employees now on the horizon, the company is working to increase awareness of its operations and opportunities.

The project represents not only an expansion of Quality Tank Solutions' manufacturing capabilities, but also an investment in jobs, workforce training and career opportunities in Marshfield and central Wisconsin.

## Marshfield Woman Arrested Following Domestic Disturbance, Special Response Team Deployment



MARSHFIELD, Wis. — A 26-year-old Marshfield woman was taken into custody Thursday evening following a domestic disturbance that led to the deployment of the Marshfield Police Department's Special Response Team.

According to a news release from the Marshfield Police Department, officers responded at approximately 6:46 p.m. Thursday, Aug. 27, to the 2700 block of West Fifth Street for a reported domestic disturbance.

Police said the woman refused to exit the residence. Approximately 45 minutes after officers arrived, the department's Special Response Team was activated after authorities determined that the woman was armed inside the residence.

Specialized police tactics were used during the incident, and a police K-9

was deployed to assist officers in taking the woman into custody. She was arrested approximately two hours later.

The woman was transported to a local emergency department for medical clearance before being taken to the Wood County Jail.

Marshfield police are requesting charges through the Wood County District Attorney's Office for false imprisonment, strangulation, disorderly conduct and battery. Police said all of the requested charges include domestic abuse enhancers. Additional charges are also being requested in connection with the woman allegedly failing to comply with officers' commands.

The Marshfield Police Department thanked the Wood County Sheriff's Department and Marshfield Fire and Rescue for assisting during the incident.

Authorities said the disturbance was an isolated incident and there is no current danger to the community.

Police said no additional information will be released at this time.

## Wood County Sheriff Discusses State Fair, Public Safety and Community Programs on County Connections

MARSHFIELD, WI — Wood County Sheriff Shawn Becker joined host David Murchland for the latest edition of County Connections, covering topics ranging from the Central Wisconsin State Fair and ATV/UTV safety to license plate reader cameras, the county jail and the upcoming school year.

One of the first topics was the Central Wisconsin State Fair, which begins Tuesday, Aug. 25. Becker said the Wood County Sheriff's Department will once again have a presence at the fair, joining the Marshfield Police Department, Marshfield Fire Department, Emergency Management and Dispatch in a shared area.

Becker credited Lt. Nathan Dean with helping expand the department's presence at the fair and said the arrangement gives fairgoers an opportunity to meet local public safety personnel, ask questions and see some of the equipment used by area agencies. The Sheriff's Department's UTV is expected to be at the fair, although its MRAP armored vehicle is not expected to make an appearance this year because of space limitations.

## New Armored Vehicle Planned

Becker also provided an update on plans to replace the department's aging MRAP. The vehicle has increasingly required maintenance, and the county is preparing to order a BearCat armored vehicle designed more specifically for law enforcement and special response teams.

The new vehicle is expected to cost more than \$400,000 and could take approximately 18 months to build. Becker said the county is looking at a

lease arrangement while also pursuing grant opportunities that could help cover the expense.

## Wood County Jail Featured on National Television

The conversation also turned to the Wood County Jail's recent appearance on 120 Hours Behind Bars, which

counties' K-9 units.

The Sheriff's Department is also planning an ATV/UTV safety course on Oct. 23 at the Wood County Courthouse. Sgt. Matt Souza, who oversees recreational patrol activities, has organized several of the courses.

Becker encouraged riders to learn

passengers were inside, including a reported runaway.

He also described cases involving a missing elderly person located after a Silver Alert and a kidnapping investigation in which the technology helped authorities locate the victim and suspect.

Becker said Wood County has used the cameras for several years and would like to add additional cameras in high-traffic areas of the county.

With students preparing to return to school, Becker reminded drivers to watch for school buses and increased pedestrian traffic.

He also recognized Wood County School Resource Officer Jesse Nels, who is preparing to begin his second year serving in Auburndale. Becker described the position as a strong partnership between the school district and Sheriff's Department.

The program also previewed a Sept. 11 tribute planned by the Marshfield Senior High School football program to mark the 25th anniversary of the terrorist attacks of Sept. 11, 2001. Becker said a combined law enforcement and fire honor guard is expected to participate in the tribute before the football game.

Murchland closed the program by encouraging residents to enjoy upcoming community events while keeping safety in mind, particularly when participating in ATV and UTV recreation.

Becker said aired on Discovery on Aug. 10.

According to Becker, the episode focused exclusively on the Wood County Sheriff's Department and gave viewers a look at both the jail and the work performed by corrections officers. He said one of the highlights was seeing the professionalism and interactions of staff members with inmates.

"For me, it's the staff," Becker said, explaining that the program gives the public an opportunity to see what corrections officers do and how they interact with those in custody.

## ATV/UTV Ride and Safety Course Coming Up

With ATV and UTV recreation continuing to grow in popularity, Becker discussed an upcoming fundraising ride beginning at Club Forest on Sept. 19. The ride will travel through portions of Portage and Wood counties and raise money for the two

not only how to safely operate their machines but also where they can legally ride. Routes and requirements can vary among counties, towns and municipalities.

Another major topic was the use of Flock license plate reader cameras.

Becker acknowledged concerns about privacy and misuse of the technology but said the cameras have provided law enforcement with an important investigative tool. He stressed that agencies need safeguards and must hold officers accountable if the systems are misused.

Becker cited several examples in which the cameras have assisted authorities. In one recent case, a vehicle reported stolen in Iowa was detected traveling from Portage County toward Wood County. Officers and deputies were able to position themselves to intercept the vehicle. After the driver fled from an attempted traffic stop, authorities eventually stopped the vehicle near Wisconsin Rapids. Becker said two
